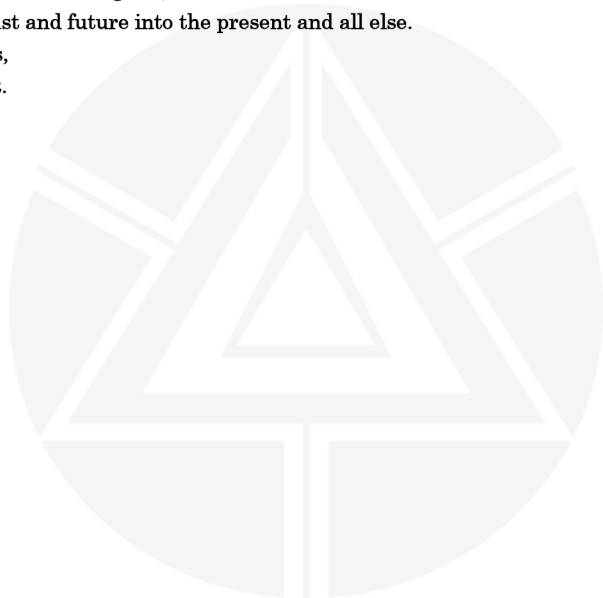


**WISDOM

No beginning,  
there is eternal persistence.  
We are in every moment.  
Reach into your self,  
you will touch the jewel of time.  
A sculpted refraction,  
like wafer-thin mirrored glass,  
breaks the past and future into the present and all else.  
Bend the lens,  
shift the light.



Our mind tells us,  
that a reflection can only display a past image.  
The light,  
leaving the ceiling lamp,  
takes time to reach us,  
bounce off of us,  
and reflect from the mirror towards our eyes.

Indeterminacy means we cannot possess all information.


It means that we take risks when we make decisions.

This does not mean that we should forgo decision making,  
as this would stop us from maximizing our chances of a desirable result.

It also does not mean that we should abandon planning,  
as planning increases our odds of success.

It means that we must accept that something,  
or everything,  
could go wrong.

This should keep us humble,  
and also,  
nimble.



Evil and good are metaphors and shouldn't be thought of as transcendent qualities.

According to OCI,

evil and good exist on three dimensions:

Closer to good: Knowledge, Intention, and Perseverance

Closer to evil: Ignorance, Impulse, and Abandonment

The first spectrum is:

Ignorance as evil<----->Knowledge as good

The second spectrum is:

Impulse as evil<----->Intent as good

The third spectrum is:

Abandonment as evil<-----> Perseverance as good

These are called good because they increase the odds of a desirable result.

Evil is what is left when one abandons one's intentions,  
refuses to learn,  
or acts out of impulse.

There is no transcendent good and evil.

This is just a useful metaphor.

The more you desire to see,  
the further you must recede.  
If you are close enough,  
you can see a grain of sand.  
If you travel far enough,  
you can see an entire city.  
The more of the light you wish to see,  
the further from it you must recede.  
The more light you wish to witness,  
the further into darkness you must retreat.



What is morality?

In extreme example,  
we say murder is immoral.

Let us start with reality and reason backwards:

Do people take the lives of other people?

Yes.

This is a fact.

So, either:

There are exceptions to the prohibition on murder,

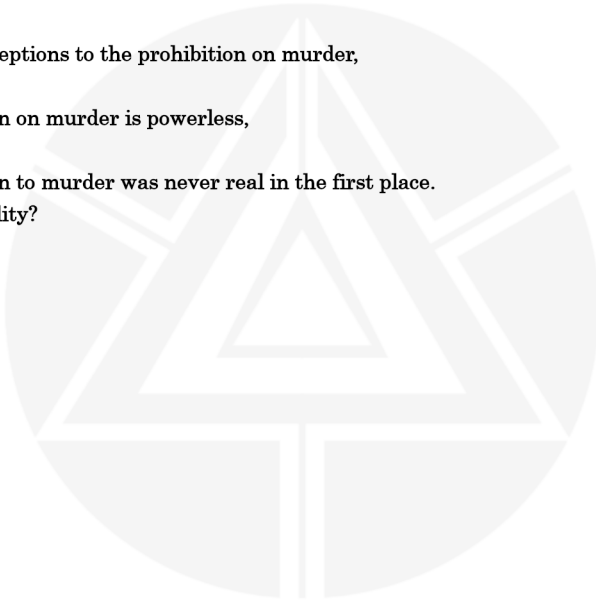
or,

require life.


So,

You are the mover.

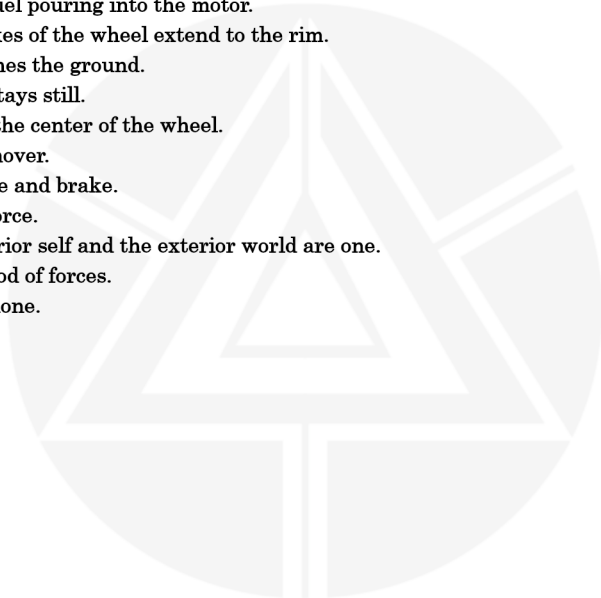
You accelerate and brake.
